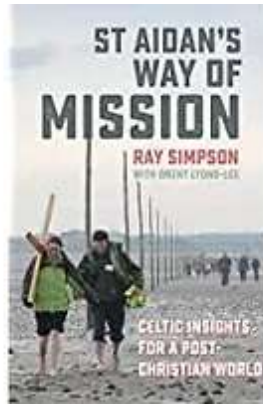

Join us to discuss , “St Aidan’s Way of Mission”. In 635 ad Aidan was called from Iona to establish a mission work in Northumberland. Although Aidan founded the monastery on Lindisfarne he travelled widely in Northumberland serving the mission of God. Ray Simpson is the founder of the Community of Aidan and Hilda (www.aidanandhilda.org.uk) and has written many books on the Celtic church. This book takes lessons from the life of Aidan and applies them to mission in our contemporary situations. This is a very helpful book in highlighting lessons which we can learn from the Celtic tradition for service in our city and nation.
