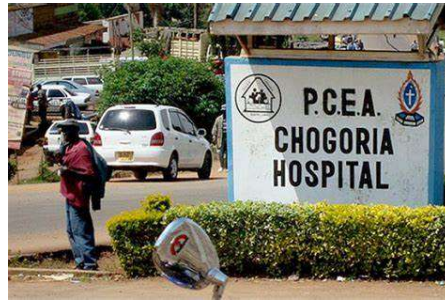

Monday 29 January 2024 at 7.30pm in Craiglockhart Church to discuss Tim Chester's book *Enjoying God: Experience the power and love of God in everyday life*. We believe in God, we serve God, we love God, **but do we ENJOY God** as much as we can? Does our head knowledge translate into affection of the heart? Do we have a meaningful relationship with someone we can't see? Do we feel excited about God every day, in every context? This isn't a book about the Trinity. It's a "how to" book exploring how we relate to God (for which we need a true understanding of the Trinity).
